Each year, the Westfall Education Foundation honors a community member who has demonstrated service to the Westfall Community by giving of his or her time, talents and treasures. The honoree exemplifies service to others. This year the Westfall Education Foundation's honoree is Jackie Eitel.

Jackie Eitel dedicated 35 and a half years to teaching in the Westfall Local School District, beginning as a substitute in 1989 before teaching third grade at Darby Elementary in 1991 and later transferring to Jackson Elementary in 1995. While earning a Master's degree from Ashland University, she became a gifted intervention specialist, serving gifted students at Westfall Elementary for most of her career. Recognized for her contributions, she was a Title One reading intervention specialist, earned the Master Teacher designation, received the 2006 Teacher of the Year award from the Ohio Association for Gifted Children, and held leadership roles in various professional and community organizations, including the Westfall Education Foundation and the Field of Dreams Committee. After returning to the regular classroom in 2018, she taught fourth grade until May 2024, leaving a lasting impact through her dedication to lifelong learning and her kind, supportive teaching environment

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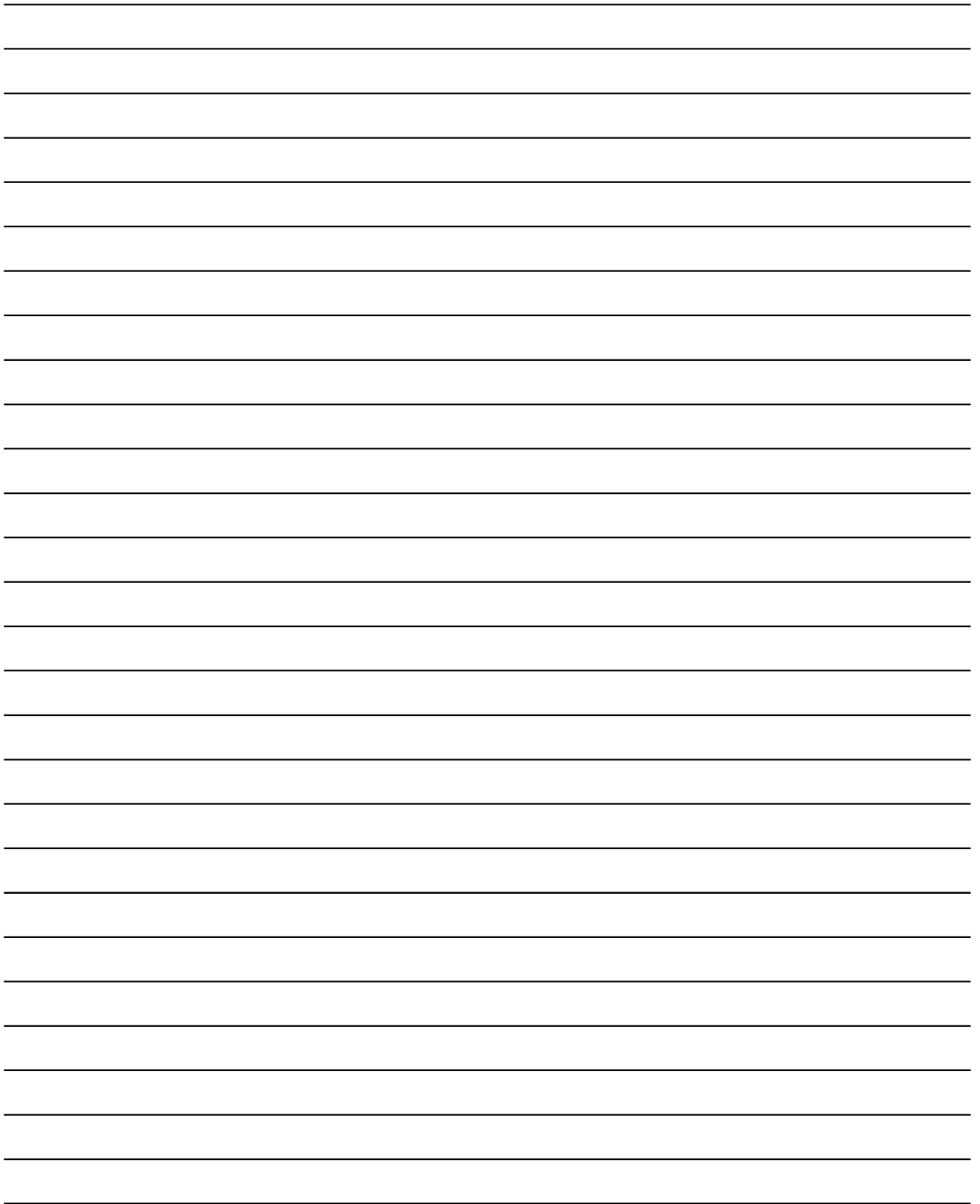
